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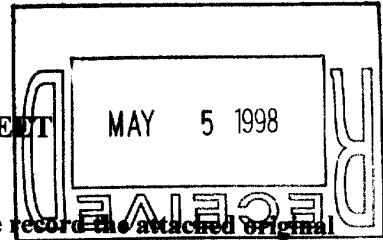

ASSIGNMENT OF REGISTERED TRADEMARKS

IN CONSIDERATION of the foregoing, and for other good and valuable consideration, the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows.


1. Seller assigns to Buyer all of its right, title, and interest in and to the trademarks listed above, including all goodwill and trade dress associated therewith.
