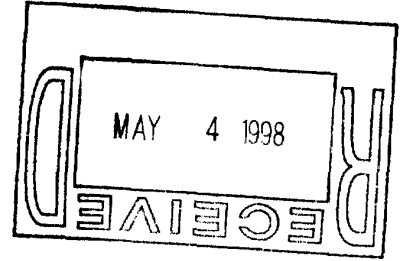

**NUNC PRO TUNC ASSIGNMENT OF TRADEMARKS**
