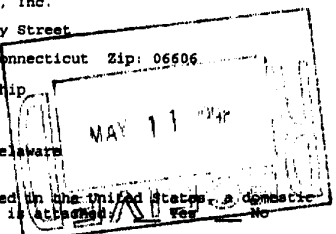

**ASSIGNMENT OF SECURITY INTEREST IN PATENTS AND TRADEMARKS**

Furthermore, the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks is expressly requested to issue directly to Bridgeport all Letters Patent resulting from said Applications or any continuation or division thereof.
