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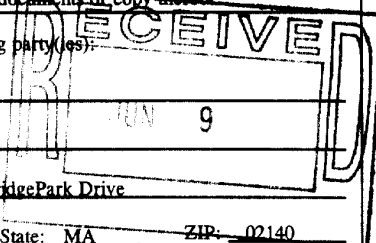

ASSIGNMENT OF TRADEMARKS

WHEREAS, Genuity Inc. (or Internet Media Network, Inc. in the case of CENTERPRISE), a corporation organized and existing under the laws Nevada and having a place of business at 50 California Street, San Francisco, CA 94111 (hereinafter "ASSIGNOR"), has adopted the trademarks which are the subject of applications for trademark registration pending in the United States Patent and Trademark Office identified in the attached Schedule A; and

WHEREAS, BBN Corporation, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, having a place of business at 150 Cambridgepark Drive, Cambridge, MA 02140 (hereinafter "ASSIGNEE"), is the successor to ASSIGNOR's Business to which the aforesaid trademarks pertain and is desirous of acquiring the aforesaid trademarks and the right to file the aforesaid trademarks in foreign countries, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by the trademarks, the aforesaid applications therefor, that portion of ASSIGNOR's business which is associated with the trademarks, and the right to recover damages for any past and future acts of infringement.

the trademarks, and the right to recover damages for any past and future acts of infringement.
