

ASSIGNMENT OF

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY AGREEMENT

THIS ASSIGNMENT OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY AGREEMENT (as may be amended, supplemented and otherwise modified from time to time, "Assignment") is made and effective as of June 1, 1998, by and between FIRST UNION NATIONAL BANK (as successor in interest to Signet Bank and including any additional successor, assignee or transferee thereof, "Assignor") and MCG FINANCE CORPORATION (including any successor, participant, assignee or transferee thereof, "Assignee").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Assignor and RAM Technologies, Inc. ("Grantor") have entered into a certain Intellectual Property Security Agreement dated as of March 3, 1995 (as amended from time to time, "IP Security Agreement"), a copy of which (including the schedules thereto setting forth with particularity the copyrights, trademarks, trademark applications and patents as to which the security interest is being assigned) is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Assignor and Assignee have entered into an Asset Purchase Agreement dated as of March 11, 1998 (as amended from time to time, including as amended to transfer the rights and obligations of the Buyer thereunder from MCG Credit Corporation to Assignee, "Purchase Agreement") pursuant to which Assignee has agreed to purchase certain loans and other assets from Assignor; and

WHEREAS, under the terms of the Purchase Agreement, Assignor also has agreed to assign its right, title and interest in and to the IP Security Agreement to Assignee;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, and intending to be legally bound hereby, Assignor and Assignee hereby agree as follows:

- 1. <u>Recitals</u>. The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein and made a part hereof as though actually stated herein.
- 2. <u>Assignment</u>. Assignor hereby assigns all of its right, title and interest in and to the IP Security Agreement (and the security interests represented thereby) to Assignee.
- 3. <u>Requested Recordation</u>. Assignee authorizes and requests that the Register of Copyrights and the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks (and any state, foreign or other authorities to which this Assignment is submitted) to file and record this Assignment (and any corresponding or separate application forms of such jurisdiction) in order to publicly reflect Assignee's interest in the IP Security Agreement.
- 4. <u>Further Assurances.</u> Assignor hereby agrees to cooperate with Assignee and, from time to time, to execute and deliver such other documents, instruments and assignments and to do all such further acts and things as may be necessary or desirable to assign the IP Security Agreement (or the security interests thereunder) or otherwise to carry out the intent of the parties hereunder.

5. <u>Miscellaneous</u>. This Assignment has been entered into in conjunction with the provisions of the Purchase Agreement. In the event that any provisions of this Assignment are deemed to conflict with the Purchase Agreement, the provisions of the Purchase Agreement shall govern. This Assignment may be executed in any number of counterparts with the same effect as if all the signatures on such counterparts appeared on one document; each such counterpart will be deemed to be an original but all counterparts together will constitute one and the same instrument.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY AGREEMENT

THIS INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY AGREEMENT (as may be amended, supplemented and otherwise modified from time to time, "IP Security Agreement") is made and effective as of March 3, 1995, by RAM TECHNOLOGIES, INC., a Kentucky corporation (including any successor or permitted assign thereof, "Grantor" or "Borrower"), in favor of SIGNET BANK/VIRGINIA, a Virginia-chartered, federally insured commercial bank (including any successor, participant, transferee or assignee thereof, "Lender").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Grantor desires and has applied to Lender for a credit facility consisting of a reducing availability balance line of credit arrangement pursuant to which Borrower can initially borrow up to \$10 million from time to time (which availability will periodically decline over the term of the credit arrangement); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that certain Credit Facility Agreement by and between Borrower and Lender dated as of March 3, 1995 (as may be amended from time to time, "Credit Agreement"), a condition precedent to Lender's obligation to execute and perform under the Credit Agreement is that Grantor shall have executed and delivered that certain Security Agreement by and between Grantor and Lender dated as of March 3, 1995 (as may be amended from time to time, "Security Agreements") encumbering all of Grantor's tangible and intangible personal property assets in favor of Lender; and

WHEREAS, under the terms of the Security Agreement, Grantor has agreed to assign certain intellectual property to Lender for purposes of securing the obligations of Borrower to Lender; and

WHEREAS, Grantor has determined that it is in its best interest to execute this Security Agreement inasmuch as Grantor will derive substantial direct and indirect benefits from the funding of the Advances to Borrower by Lender pursuant to the Credit Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Grantor and Lender hereby agree as follows:

- 1. Grant. Grantor hereby grants to Lender an absolute, present, unconditional, continuing first priority security interest in and to all of Grantor's entire right, title and interest in and to the following property and rights (collectively, the "Collateral"):
- (a) The copyrights, associated U.S. copyright registrations and applications for copyright registration, and copyright licenses set forth on Exhibit \underline{A} attached hereto (collectively, the "Copyrights"); and

- (b) The U.S. and foreign patents and patent applications, and patent licenses set forth on Exhibit B attached hereto, including, without limitation, improvements, divisions, continuations, renewals, reissues, extensions and continuations-in-part of the same (collectively, the "Patents"); and
- (c) The U.S. and foreign trademark and service mark registrations, trademark and service mark applications, and trademark and service mark licenses set forth on Exhibit C attached hereto (including all associated goodwill, collectively, the "Trademarks"); and
- (d) Any and all claims and causes of action for past, present or future infringement of any of the Collateral, with the right, but not the obligation, to sue for and collect damages for infringement of the Collateral; and
- (e) Any and all licenses or rights granted under any of the Collateral, and all license fees and royalties arising from such licenses or rights, to the extent permitted by such licenses or rights; and
- (f) Any and all amendments, renewals, extensions, reissuances and replacements of any of the Collateral; and
 - (g) Any and all products and proceeds of any of the foregoing.
- 2. Requested Recordation. Grantor authorizes and requests that the Register of Copyrights, and the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks (and any state or other authorities to which this IP Security Agreement is submitted) to file and record this IP Security Agreement.
- 3. <u>Assignment</u>. Upon the occurrence and during the continuance of an Event of Default (as defined in the Security Agreement), Grantor shall execute and deliver to Lender an absolute assignment transferring its entire right, title, and interest in and to the Collateral to Lender.
- 4. <u>Power of Attorney</u>. Grantor hereby grants Lender a power of attorney, to act as Grantor's attorney-in-fact, with full authority in the place and stead of Grantor in the name of Grantor, Lender or otherwise, from time to time in Lender's discretion, to take any action and to execute any instrument which Lender may deem reasonably necessary or advisable to accomplish the purposes of the Security Agreement or this IP Security Agreement, including, without limitation:
- (a) To modify, in its sole discretion, this IP Security Agreement without first obtaining Grantor's approval of or signature to such modification by amending Exhibit A, Exhibit B, and/or Exhibit C hereof, as appropriate, to include reference to any Collateral acquired by Grantor after the execution hereof or to delete any reference to any Collateral in which Grantor no longer has or claims any right, title or interest; and

- (b) To execute and file, in its sole discretion, any document, including, without limitation, (i) any financing statement or continuation statement or any amendment thereto, and/or (ii) any document in any proceeding before the United States Patent and Trademark Office and the United States Copyright Office, to maintain or pursue any application (and to obtain the relevant registration) filed with respect to, and to maintain any registration of any of the Collateral, including the filing of applications for renewal, affidavits of use, affidavits of incontestability-and opposition, interference and cancellation proceedings and the payment of fees and taxes without the signature of Grantor when permitted by law; and
- (c) To execute an assignment or any other document required to acknowledge or register or perfect Lender's interest in any part of the Collateral without the signature of Grantor when permitted by law.

Such power of attorney is coupled with an interest and is irrevocable.

- 5. Release. At such time as Grantor has completely satisfied all of the obligations secured hereby (unconditionally and indefeasibly) and any period during which any payments under any of the Loan Documents are subject to challenge or return has expired, Lender (at Grantor's request and expense) will execute and deliver to Grantor (without representation, warranty or recourse of any kind) an instrument, in writing, releasing the security interest in the Collateral acquired under this IP Security Agreement, subject to any disposition thereof which may have been made by Lender pursuant to this IP Security Agreement, the Security Agreement or the Credit Agreement.
- 6. <u>Miscellaneous</u>. This IP Security Agreement has been entered into in conjunction with the provisions of and the security interest granted to Lender under the Security Agreement. The rights and remedies of Grantor and Lender with respect to the security interest granted herein are in addition and without prejudice to those set forth in the Security Agreement and the Credit Agreement, all terms and provisions of which are hereby incorporated herein by reference. This IP Security Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts with the same effect as if all the signatures on such counterparts appeared on one document; each such counterpart will be deemed to be an original but all counterparts together will constitute one and the same instrument. In the event that any provisions of this IP Security Agreement are deemed to conflict with the Security Agreement or the Credit Agreement, the provisions of the Security Agreement or Credit Agreement shall govern.
