FIRST: That the Board of Directors of said corporation, by the unanimous written consent of its members, filed with the minutes of the Board, adopted a resolution proposing and declaring advisable the following amendment to the Certificate of Incorporation of said corporation:

RESOLVED, that the first paragraph of the Certificate of Incorporation of General Cable IP Corporation shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

"FIRST: The name of the corporation is General Cable Technologies Corporation."
