ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

This Assignment Agreement is made this 4th day of September, 1998 by NORWEST BUSINESS CREDIT, INC., a Minnesota corporation ("NBCI") for the benefit of BLOUNT, INC., a Delaware corporation.

Recitals

A. NBCI has received an assignment of certain trademarks and patent applications, as more particularly described in Exhibit A, attached hereto, from Redfield Rifle Scopes, Inc. ("Redfield") (collectively, the "Intellectual Property").

B. NBCI has loaned Redfield certain amounts and has received a valid and perfected first priority security interest in certain assets of Redfield to secure the loans. The loans from NBCI now are in default. Pursuant to Section 9-504 of the Uniform Commercial Code, NBCI has agreed to sell to Blount, Inc. certain assets, including the Intellectual Property at a duly notice private foreclosure sale.

Agreements

Now therefore, in consideration of the foregoing and the parties hereby agree as follows: NBCI hereby assigns to Blount all of the above identified Intellectual Property, including all goodwill of the business symbolized by the Intellectual Property.

Effective this 4th day of September, 1998.

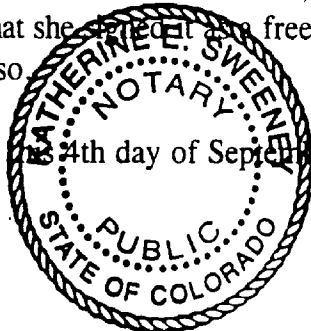
