cancellation, to cooperate with Assignee in the matter of giving and producing evidence in support and by preparing and executing documents therefor, and further to perform, upon such request, any and all affirmative acts to obtain or retain said Mark and/or registration and vest all rights therein hereby conveyed in this Assignment.


