**ASSIGNMENT OF REGISTERED TRADEMARK  
TO SUCCESSOR OF BUSINESS**

Whereas The Spinalator Company, a North Carolina corporation, now dissolved (hereinafter referred to as "the Company"), has been succeeded by the Enloe/Arnold Partnership, having as its address 175 Bent Tree Road, Asheville, North Carolina 28804 (hereinafter referred to as "the Partnership"); and

Whereas the Partnership includes as partners all of the former shareholders of the Company; and

Whereas the Partnership has assumed the ownership of certain assets of the Company, including the following trademark:

**SPINALATOR**, which was registered in the United States Patent and Trademark Office under Registration No. 357,815 on June 14, 1938, and last renewed effective June 14, 1978;

(hereinafter referred to as "the mark"); and

Whereas the Company or the Partnership has adopted, used and is using the mark through a related company, namely Chattanooga Group, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "CGI") in connection with the sale of a mechanical treatment table more specifically described as an upholstered table with an opening or slot near the head over which a patient lies on his back, (operating through said slot is a series of rollers motivated by an electric motor, that alternately raises and lowers the patient, obtaining passive motion in the joints of the spinal column; the height of the rollers is adjustable; this passive motion relieves muscular tension, ligamentous rigidity, vascular stasis, and odema, which is beneficial in promoting health and vigor) (hereinafter referred to as "the business"); and

Whereas CGI, a Delaware corporation having as the address of its principal place of business 4717 Adams Road, Post Office Box 489, Hixson, Tennessee 37343, has succeeded to the operation of and has acquired the assets and appurtenant goodwill of the business;

Now, Therefore, in consideration of the sum of ten dollars and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, The Spinalator Company and the Enloe/Arnold Partnership hereby assign to Chattanooga Group, Inc. all right, title and interest in and to the mark and the U.S. registration thereof that is described above, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by the mark and the registration thereof.
