TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, Uni-Pak Film Systems, Inc., a Georgia corporation with its offices at 313 Berwick Court, Heathrow, Florida 32746 (hereinafter "**Uni-Pak**"), is the owner of all right, title and interest in and to certain trademarks and all goodwill associated therewith; and

WHEREAS, McDowell International Packaging Systems, Inc., a Florida corporation with its offices at 5505 Carter Road, Orlando, Florida 32810-4707 (hereinafter "**McDowell**"), is desirous of acquiring the entire right, title and interest in and to such trademarks and associated goodwill;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it known that:

1. As used herein, the term "Trademarks" shall include the following:

In consideration of the sum of One United States Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Uni-Pak hereby sells, assigns and transfers to McDowell Uni-Pak's entire right, title and interest in and to the Trademarks throughout all countries of the world, specifically including but not limited to Canada, and all goodwill associated therewith. Such assignment includes all rights to the now-expired registrations identified in Paragraph 1 hereof, all common-law rights associated with the Trademarks, and all rights to seek any registrations of the Trademarks.
