## ASSIGNMENT FOR SECURITY - TRADEMARKS AND PATENTS

WHEREAS, INAMED CORPORATION, a Florida corporation, McGHAN MEDICAL CORPORATION, a California corporation, CUI CORPORATION, a California corporation, INAMED DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, a California corporation, BIODERMIS CORPORATION, a Nevada corporation, BIOENTERICS CORPORATION, a California corporation and BIOPLEXUS CORPORATION, a Nevada corporation (herein collectively referred to as the "Company"), have adopted, used and are using certain trademarks (the "Trademarks"), and own certain patents and patent applications (such patents and patent applications and all continuations, divisions, reissues and extensions thereof collectively, the "Patents");

WHEREAS, the Company is indebted to the holders of the Secured Convertible Notes due 1999 of INAMED Corporation (the "Convertible Notes") issued pursuant to that Indenture dated January 2, 1996 between INAMED Corporation and Santa Barbara Bank & Trust, as Trustee (the "Trustee") and the Company has previously entered into a Security Agreement and a Guarantee and Security Agreement (the "Agreements") in favor of the Trustee;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Agreements, the Company has previously assigned to the Trustee and granted to the Trustee a security interest in, and mortgage on, all right, title and interest of the Company in and to the Trademarks, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by the Trademarks, the Patents and all proceeds thereof, including, without limitation, any and all causes of action which may exist by reason of infringement thereof, to secure the prompt payment, performance and observance of the Secured Obligations, as defined in the Agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Company has agreed to assign certain additional Patents and Trademarks, all as listed on the annexed Schedule A (the "Collateral") to the Trustee;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Company does hereby assign unto the Trustee and grant to the Trustee a security interest in, and mortgage on, the Collateral to secure the prompt payment, performance and observance of the obligations of the Company pursuant to the terms of the Convertible Notes.

The Company further agrees to execute and deliver any and all further assignments and other documents required by the Trustee to apply for, obtain, maintain, issue and to vest or perfect title in the Trustee or its successors and assigns.


