RELEASE AND TERMINATION AGREEMENT dated as of March 24, 1998, among JEFFERSON SMURFIT CORPORATION, a Delaware corporation ("JSC"), JSCE, INC., a Delaware corporation ("JSCE"), JEFFERSON SMURFIT CORPORATION (U.S.), a Delaware corporation (the "Borrower"), SMURFIT NEWSPRINT CORPORATION, a Delaware corporation ("SNC"), THE CHASE MANHATTAN BANK, a New York banking corporation (formerly named Chemical Bank) ("Chase"), and BANKERS TRUST COMPANY, a New York banking corporation ("BTCo" and, together with Chase in such capacity, the "1996 Senior Managing Agents"), as senior managing agents for the lenders (the "1996 Lenders") that are parties to the Existing Credit Agreement (as defined below), Chase, as administrative agent (in such capacity, the "1996 Administrative Agent") and as collateral agent (in such capacity, the "1996 Collateral Agent") for the 1996 Lenders, and as swingline lender (in such capacity, the "1996 Swingline Lender"), and BTCo, as fronting bank (in such capacity, the "1996 Fronting Bank"). Capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the meanings assigned to such terms in the Existing Credit Agreement.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Credit Agreement dated as of May 11, 1994, as amended and restated as of May 16, 1996, as further amended as of September 30, 1996 and June 15, 1997 (the "Existing Credit Agreement"), among JSC, JSCE, the Borrower, the 1996 Lenders, the 1996 Senior Managing Agents, the 1996 Administrative Agent, the 1996 Collateral Agent, the 1996 Swingline Lender and the 1996 Fronting Bank, the 1996 Lenders have made available Loans, the 1996 Swingline Lender has made available Swingline Loans and the 1996 Fronting Bank has made available Letters of Credit;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Security Documents, the Loan Parties have granted to the 1996 Collateral Agent, and its successors and assigns, for the benefit of the Secured Parties, and their successors and assigns, a security interest in, lien on and pledge of the Collateral to secure the payment and performance of the Obligations;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Guarantee Agreement and the SNC Guarantee Agreement, the Guarantors and SNC, respectively, have guaranteed the payment and performance of the Obligations; and

WHEREAS, the Borrower is simultaneously with the effectiveness of this Agreement prepaying in full the Loans, the Swingline Loans and all other Obligations under the Existing Credit Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the prepayment in full of the Loans, the Swingline Loans and the other Obligations and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto hereby agree as follows:

1. Each of JSC, JSCE, the Borrower, SNC, the 1996 Senior Managing Agents, the 1996 Administrative Agent (on behalf of the 1996 Lenders) and the 1996 Collateral Agent hereby agree that the Existing Credit Agreement has terminated in accordance with its terms. In furtherance of the foregoing, the 1996 Administrative Agent (on behalf of the 1996 Lenders) and the 1996 Collateral Agent do hereby (a) release and discharge JSC, JSCE, the Borrower, SNC and each other Loan Party from any and all obligations, covenants and agreements under the Security Documents, the Guarantee Agreement and the SNC Guarantee Agreement, as applicable, (b) declare the same fully released and discharged and (c) release and discharge any and all right, title and interest that they may have, or to which they may be entitled, in the Collateral.

2. Each of the 1996 Administrative Agent and the 1996 Collateral Agent agree to execute and deliver to any Loan Party any irrevocable stock powers, mortgage and deed of trust satisfactions or reconveyances and other documents and instruments that JSC, JSCE, the Borrower or SNC shall reasonably request in order to effectuate the release and discharge described in Section 1 above.

3. The 1996 Administrative Agent (on behalf of the 1996 Lenders) stipulates and agrees that, upon receipt by the 1996 Administrative Agent for the benefit of the 1996 Lenders of \$880,244,693.38, all the Obligations of the Borrower under the Existing Credit Agreement will have been fully paid or performed.

4. Each of JSC, JSCE, the Borrower, the 1996 Administrative Agent, the 1996 Lenders, the 1996 Swingline Lender and the 1996 Fronting Bank agree that (a) the 1996 Fronting Bank shall have no further obligation to issue

Letters of Credit under the Existing Credit Agreement and (b) the 1996 Lenders and the 1996 Swingline Lender have no further obligation to lend or reimburse the 1996 Fronting Bank for any drawings or other amounts with respect to any outstanding Letters of Credit (it being understood and agreed that any outstanding Letters of Credit shall not be canceled but shall be deemed to be issued under the 1998 Credit Agreement (as defined below)).

5. Each of JSC, JSCE, the Borrower and SNC, jointly and severally, agree to pay any and all stamp and other taxes (excluding income and income-related taxes) and fees payable or determined to be payable in connection with the execution and delivery, filing or recording of instruments and documents delivered or that may be delivered in connection with this Agreement or the transactions contemplated hereby, and agree to hold the 1996 Administrative Agent, the 1996 Lenders, the 1996 Swingline Lender and the 1996 Fronting Bank harmless from and against any and all liabilities with respect to or resulting from any delay in paying or omitting to pay such taxes or fees

6. This Agreement shall become effective only after (a) counterparts hereof have been executed and delivered by JSC, JSCE, the Borrower, SNC, the 1996 Senior Managing Agents, the 1996 Administrative Agent, the 1996 Collateral Agent and the 1996 Swingline Lender and (b) the 1996 Administrative Agent has received by wire transfer immediately available funds in the amount specified in Section 3 above.

7. THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE GOVERNED BY, AND CONSTRUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH, THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK.

8. This Agreement may be executed in two or more counterparts, each of which shall constitute an original but all of which when taken together shall constitute one agreement, and shall become effective as provided in Section 6 above.

9. This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of JSC, JSCE, the Borrower, SNC, the other Loan Parties, the 1996 Lenders, the 1996 Administrative Agent, the 1996 Senior Managing Agents, the 1996 Swingline Lender, the 1996 Fronting Bank and the 1996 Collateral Agent and their respective successors and assigns. The parties hereto acknowledge and agree that the lenders under that certain Credit Agreement dated as of the date hereof (the "1998 Credit Agreement"), among JSC, JSCE, the Borrower, the financial institutions party thereto as

lenders, BCo and Chase, as senior managing agents, Chase as swingline lender, administrative agent and collateral agent, and the managing agents and fronting banks named therein, are intended third-party beneficiaries hereof. Nothing contained herein, expressed or implied, shall affect the rights and obligations of any of the foregoing under the 1998 Credit Agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have caused this Agreement to be duly executed by their respective authorized officers as of the day and year first above written.


