ASSIGNMENT OF MARK

THIS TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT (this "Assignment") made effective the 13th day of July, 1979, by W.G.M. Products Company, Inc., a Michigan corporation ("ASSIGNOR"), to Variform, Inc., a Missouri corporation ("ASSIGNEE");

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, ASSIGNOR is the owner of (i) the trademark shown on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, and (ii) any trade dress associated with said mark [referred to hereinafter as "the Mark"], together with the goodwill of the business symbolized thereby in connection with vinyl siding ("the Products"); and

WHEREAS, ASSIGNOR changed its name to its current name from Fashionwall Products Company, Inc., on November 7, 1996, and changed its name to Fashionwall Products Company, Inc., from Chateau Products Company on July 31, 1979.

WHEREAS, ASSIGNOR desires to convey, transfer, assign, deliver, and contribute to ASSIGNEE all of its right, title, and interest in and to the Mark.

ASSIGNMENT

1. For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, ASSIGNOR hereby conveys, transfers, assigns, delivers, and contributes to ASSIGNEE all of ASSIGNOR'S right, title, and interest in and to the Mark, together with (1) the goodwill of the business relating to the Products in respect of which the Mark is used; (2) all income, royalties, and damages hereafter due or payable to ASSIGNOR with respect to the Mark, including without limitation damages and payments for past or future infringements and misappropriations of the Mark; and (3) all rights to sue for past, present, and future infringements or misappropriations of the Mark.

2. ASSIGNOR further conveys, transfers, assigns, delivers, and contributes to ASSIGNEE all rights in the trade dress, labels, and designs associated with the Mark.
