ASSIGNMENT OF TRADEMARKS

This Assignment of Trademarks ("Assignment") is made this 5th day of February, 1999 by and between Blue Coral Systems, Inc. (formerly known as Blue Coral Chemical, Inc.), a Delaware corporation ("Assignor") and Ecolab Inc., a Delaware corporation ("Assignee").

WHEREAS, Assignor and Assignee, among others, have entered into an Asset Purchase Agreement dated January 6, 1999 (the "Agreement"), providing for, among other things, the sale by Assignor and purchase by Assignee of the Purchased Assets;

WHEREAS, unless otherwise defined herein, capitalized words and phrases used herein shall have the same meaning as they have in the Agreement;

WHEREAS, Assignor is the owner of the entire right, title and interest in and to all common law and registered trademarks/service marks, logos, artistic and moral rights and slogans, trade dress, trade names, character rights and rights of priority pertaining to the Purchased Assets, all derivatives thereof, and all applications, registrations and registration certificates, Section 8 and Section 15 affidavits, renewals, investigations, search reports, histories and other documents or files pertaining thereto, including without limitation the trademarks more fully described on Schedule A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference (the "Trademarks").

WHEREAS, Assignee is desirous of acquiring the entire right, title and interest in and to the Trademarks and the common law rights in the Trademarks.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration:

Assignor does hereby sell, transfer, convey, assign, and deliver unto Assignee the entire worldwide right, title and interest in and to the Trademarks including all common law rights, connected therein together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by the Trademarks. Assignor agrees to immediately terminate and refrain from any further use of the Trademarks for any purpose and to execute any other documents necessary to effectuate and record this Assignment. Assignor further assigns to Assignee all right to sue for and receive all damages accruing from past infringements of the Trademarks herein assigned.

This Assignment shall be subject to the Agreement and in the event of any inconsistency or conflict between this Assignment and the Agreement, the terms of the Agreement shall prevail.
