



**RELEASE OF TRADEMARK SECURITY ASSIGNMENT
AND SECURITY AGREEMENT**

Release of Trademark Security Assignment and Security Agreement, (hereinafter referred to as "The Agreement") is made, executed and delivered as of January 27, 1999 by and between **CHARLES SAKMANN GOLF, INC.**, (hereinafter referred to as "The Assignor"), a Pennsylvania corporation with a principal place of business at 3130 Marion Avenue, Laureldale, Pennsylvania 19605, and the **FIRST UNION NATIONAL BANK**, (hereinafter referred to as "The Assignee"), a National Banking Association with an office or place of business at 600 Penn Street, Reading, Pennsylvania, successor by merger to the Meridian Bank and Corestates Bank N.A., as evidenced by the Merger Documents annexed hereto as Exhibit A.

WHEREAS, the Assignee obtained, pursuant to a Trademark Security Assignment and Security Agreement, each dated May 20, 1993, a security interest in the following trademarks registered with the United States Patent and Trademark Office in the name of Charles Sakmann Golf, Inc.:

(hereinafter referred to as "The Trademarks"); and

WHEREAS, Redstone Apparel Group Inc., a Canadian corporation having a principal office or place of business at 960, Beaumont Avenue, Montreal, Quebec, Canada (hereinafter referred to as "Redstone"), has been transferred all of the Assignor's rights in, among other things, Assignor's general intangibles pursuant to section 9-504 of the Pennsylvania Uniform Commercial Code and pursuant to a certain Secured Party Bill of Sale of even date by and between Assignee and Redstone; and

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Assignee hereby releases The Trademarks from the Trademark Security Assignment and Security Agreement.

NOTHING CONTAINED HEREIN SHALL BE DEEMED A RELEASE OF THE INDEBTEDNESS OWED BY ASSIGNOR AND ALL GUARANTORS TO ASSIGNEE OR A WAIVER OF ASSIGNEE'S RIGHTS AND REMEDIES.

This letter is the official certification of the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency for the merger of CoreStates Bank, National Association, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, Charter Nr. 1, into and under the charter and title of First Union National Bank, Charlotte, North Carolina, Charter Nr. 22693, effective as of May 15, 1998.

This letter also serves as the official authorization of the Comptroller of the Currency for First Union National Bank, Charter Nr. 22693, to operate the former head office of CoreStates Bank, N.A., Charter Nr. 1, as a branch at the following site:

The individual branch certifications-previously issued by the OCC to CoreStates Bank, N.A., Charter Nr. 1, convey automatically to First Union National Bank, Charter Nr. 22693, and will not be reissued in the name of the resulting bank. A copy of this letter should be furnished to the Bank's branch administration personnel.

I also wish to advise you, on behalf of Deputy Comptroller Doug Roeder, Large Bank Supervision, that he has approved the Bank's request for permission to have an aggregate investment in fixed assets of up to \$3,500,000,000.00. His approval is conditioned upon the application of generally accepted accounting principles towards those investments. Future requests for increases in that limit should be directed to Deputy Comptroller Roeder.

I am also glad to inform you that, as a courtesy, the Comptroller has granted your request that Charter Nr. 1 be reassigned to the bank resulting from this merger. On May 18, 1998, a date subsequent to the merger having been consummated, the records of First Union National Bank, Charlotte, North Carolina, will be altered to reflect this new charter designation.
