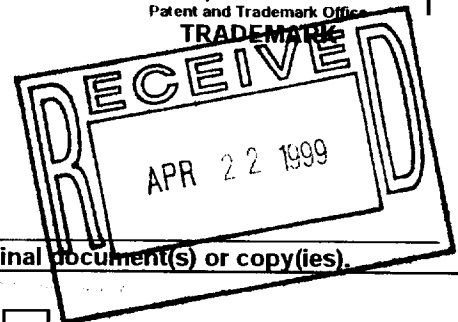

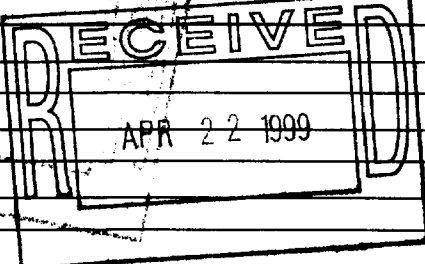

RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

WHEREAS,

MCCRAY LUMBER COMPANY

A CORPORATION ORGANIZED UNDER THE GENERAL AND BUSINESS CORPORATION LAW HAS FILED IN THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE DUPLICATE ORIGINALS OF RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION AND HAS, IN ALL RESPECTS, COMPLIED WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE GENERAL AND BUSINESS CORPORATION LAW GOVERNING RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION, AND THAT SAID RESTATED ARTICLES

SUPERCEDE THE ORIGINAL ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION AND ALL AMENDMENTS THERETO.

Restated Articles of Incorporation
(To be submitted in duplicate)

Pursuant to the provisions of The General and Business Corporation Law of Missouri, the undersigned corporation certifies the following:

1. The present name of the corporation is **McCray Lumber Company**. The name under which it was originally organized was **McCray Lumber Company**.
2. These Restated Articles of Incorporation were adopted by a majority of the Board of Directors of the corporation on **February 25, 1999**.
3. These Restated Articles of Incorporation correctly set forth, without change, the corresponding provisions of the Articles of Incorporation as theretofore amended and supersede the original Articles of Incorporation and all amendments thereto.
4. The Articles of Incorporation are restated to read in their entirety as set forth below:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is: **McCray Lumber Company**.

ARTICLE TWO

The address of its registered office in the State of Missouri is 2900 East 150 Highway, Kansas City, Missouri, 64146, and the name of its registered agent at such address is Chandler S. McCray.

ARTICLE THREE

The corporation shall have authority to issue one million two hundred thousand (1,200,000) shares of Common Stock, par value Fifty Cents (\$.50) per share, aggregating Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000.00).

ARTICLE FOUR

No holder of issued and outstanding shares of any class of stock of the corporation shall have a preemptive right to subscribe for or acquire any shares of stock of such class or any other class, or any other securities of any kind, hereafter issued by the corporation.

ARTICLE SIX

The number of directors which shall constitute the whole Board of Directors shall be fixed by, or in the manner provided in, the Bylaws of the corporation, but shall not be less than three. Any change in the number of directors shall be reported to the Secretary of State of Missouri within thirty (30) calendar days of such change.

ARTICLE SEVEN

The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE EIGHT

The corporation is formed for profit for the purpose of conducting or engaging in any lawful business or activities for which corporations may be organized under The General and Business Corporation Law of Missouri, or any successor law thereto.

ARTICLE NINE

The Board of Directors shall have power to make, and from time to time alter, amend, or repeal the Bylaws of the corporation; provided, however, that (i) the shareholders shall have the paramount power to alter, amend and repeal the Bylaws or adopt new Bylaws, exercisable by a

majority vote of the shareholders present in person or by proxy at any annual or special meeting of shareholders, and (ii) if and to the extent the shareholders exercise such power, the Board of Directors shall not thereafter suspend, alter, amend or repeal the Bylaws, or portions thereof, adopted by the shareholders, unless, in adopting such Bylaws, or portions thereof, the shareholders otherwise provide.

ARTICLE TEN

Each outstanding share entitled to vote under these Articles of Incorporation shall be entitled to one vote on each matter submitted to a vote at a meeting of shareholders, including, without limitation, each vote taken in the election of directors. There shall be no cumulative voting in the election of directors.
