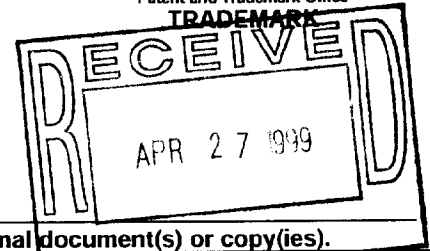

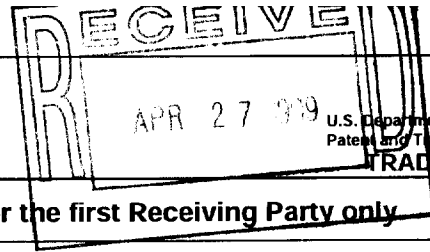


BILL OF SALE


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that YUASA, INC., a Delaware corporation ("Seller"), for good and valuable consideration, receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, and intending to be legally bound, has granted, bargained, sold, conveyed, transferred, assigned and delivered and by this Bill of Sale hereby grants, bargains, sells, conveys, transfers, assigns and delivers to ADVANCE POWER, INC., an Ohio corporation ("Purchaser") with offices at 32111 Aurora Road, Solon, OH 44139, its successors and assigns, all of the right, title and interest of Seller in and to the "Assets" (as defined in Section 1(a) of the Asset Purchase Agreement dated March 19, 1999 between Seller and Purchaser (the "Purchase Agreement"))).
