

ASSIGNMENT OF U.S. TRADEMARK

WHEREAS, First Union National Bank, a national banking corporation having an address of 1339 Chestnut Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19101 (hereinafter "Assignor"), successor by merger to CoreStates Bank, N.A., a national banking association, acquired by virtue of a security agreement and trademark assignment being filed in Reel 1732, Frame 0185 of the United States Patent and Trademark Office a security interest and all right, title and interest in and to a certain service mark which has been registered in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office, as follows: (the "Mark"):

WHEREAS, Assignee is desirous of acquiring all rights, title and interest in and to said Mark; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that Agreement dated effective March 18, 1999 by and among Assignor, Assignee and Sirrom Investments, Inc., a Tennessee corporation, Assignor has agreed to transfer to Assignee all rights, title and interest of Assignor in and to said Mark, under and subject to a first lien and security interest in favor of the Assignor.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Assignor does hereby assign, transfer and convey to Assignee, its successors, assigns, or other legal representatives, all Assignor's rights, title and interest in and to, and to the use of, the above-identified Mark, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by the Marks, the registration thereof and application therefor, and the right to recover damages for past acts of infringement of said Mark.

To the best of Assignor's knowledge, with respect to the Mark that has been registered with the United States Patent and Trademark Office or other government office, such registration is in full force and effect, and any and all fees therefor have been paid in full.

Assignor hereby consents to and requests recordation of this transfer and further authorizes and requests that all official documents and communications relating to said Mark or the registration(s) and/or application(s) therefor issue and deliver to Assignee, its attorneys, agents, successors or assigns.

Assignor hereby agrees at Assignee's request to use reasonable efforts to execute in Assignee's favor any and all additional papers which may be necessary for the transfer, by complete assignment, of all Assignor's proprietary rights in and to the above-identified Marks and all registrations thereof or applications therefor.

This Assignment is made, and shall be under and subject in all respects to, a first priority lien and security interest in favor of the Assignor.
