

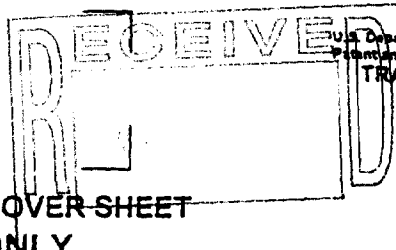

CORRECTIVE ASSIGNMENT


1. WPI INSTRUMENTS, INC., a New Hampshire Corporation, with an address of 1155 Elm Street, Manchester, New Hampshire 03101 ("WPI"), is incorrectly identified in the United States Patent and Trademark Office as the owner of the INDY AUTOMOTIVE federal registration (Reg. No. 835,904) and the good will of the business associated with the trademark (the "Trademark").
2. WPI is the successor in interest to Emico Incorporated, Emico Instruments, Inc. and Modutec, Inc. (collectively the "Predecessors").
3. Through an unintentional and inadvertent mistake, WPI and its Predecessors incorrectly recorded their ownership of the Trademark in the United States Patent and Trademark Office.
4. WPI seeks to remove itself and its Predecessors from the chain of title for the Trademark and to "return" title to the Trademark to the Indianapolis Motor Speedway Corporation, the last reported owner of the Trademark before the erroneous filings.
5. WPI seeks to correct the filings at:
reel 1827/frame 0620;
reel 1826/frame 0417; and
reel 1824/frame 0504,
to remove Reg. No. 835,904 from the list of "trademark registration numbers" on page 2 of the recordation form cover sheets.
6. On information and belief, the underlying cause of the recording error was due to the inadvertent failure of the Predecessors to remove the Trademark from its scheduled assets even though it had previously transferred the Trademark to the Indianapolis Motor Speedway Corporation.
7. By way of explanation of the Predecessors' ownership of the Trademark, Emico Incorporated merged into Emico Instruments, Inc. and recorded this merger in the United States Patent and Trademark Office at reel 1824 and frame 0504, and inadvertently included the Trademark as one of the affected properties.
8. Emico Instruments, Inc. thereafter changed its name to Modutec, Inc. and recorded this name change in the United States Patent and Trademark Office at reel 1826 and frame 0417, and inadvertently included the Trademark as one of the affected properties.
9. Modutec, Inc. thereafter assigned all of its right, title and interest in and to all of its trademarks, federal trademark registrations, and good will of the business symbolized by such trademarks to WPI, and through a good faith and inadvertent mistake, it included the Trademark as one of the assigned properties.

10. WPI does not own the "INDY AUTOMOTIVE" mark or federal registration (Reg. No. 835,904) nor any of the good will of the business associated with the Trademark, and the United States Patent and Trademark Office filing at reel 1827 and frame 0620 incorrectly identifies federal registration number 835,904 for "INDY AUTOMOTIVE" as one of the assigned properties owned by WPI.

11. WPI intends that this document constitute a corrective assignment so that the filings in the United States Patent and Trademark Office do not identify WPI or the Predecessors as the owner of the Trademark (Reg. No. 835,904) and so that the filings do reflect that title rests in the Indianapolis Motor Speedway Corporation, the last recorded owner before the above mentioned erroneous filings.
