

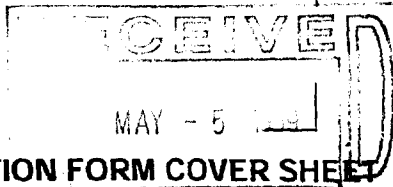

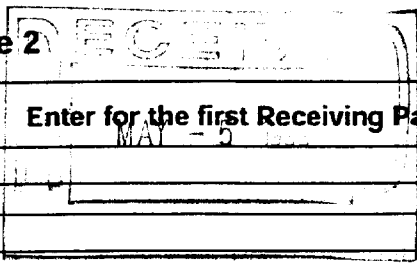

ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT, dated as of April 26, 1999, by and between Physician Computer Network, Inc., a New Jersey corporation and VERSYSS Incorporated (hereinafter referred to, collectively, as the "Assignors") and Holbrook Systems, Inc., a Delaware corporation (the "Assignee").

Background

The Assignors' are the owners of the trademarks, trademark applications and copyrights set forth on Schedule A hereto and all rights associated therewith (the "Intellectual Property").

The Assignors and Assignee are parties to a certain Asset Purchase Agreement, dated as of the date hereof (the "Agreement"), pursuant to which the Assignors have agreed to assign to Assignee all of Assignors' rights, title and interests in and to the Intellectual Property, subject to the retention by the Assignors of a joint ownership interest in certain of the Intellectual Property as specified on Schedule A hereto.

Assignee wishes to acquire all of Assignors' rights to the Intellectual Property, subject to the retention by the Assignors of a joint ownership interest in certain of the Intellectual Property as specified on Schedule A hereto.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

Section 1. Assignment

For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Assignors hereby assign, deliver and sets over unto Assignee all of the rights and obligations of the Assignors' and their respective successors and assigns to all of the Intellectual Property, subject to the retention by the Assignors of a joint ownership interest in certain of the Intellectual Property as specified on Schedule A hereto.

Section 2. Further Instruments

The parties hereto agree that they will execute and deliver, or cause to be executed and delivered, to the other such documents and instruments, in addition to those specifically required by the provisions of this Assignment Agreement, in form and substance reasonably satisfactory to the other, as may reasonably be necessary or desirable to carry out or implement any provision of this Assignment Agreement.

Section 3. Binding Nature, Governing Law

This Assignment Agreement shall (a) inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the respective successors and permitted assigns of the parties hereto and (b) be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the substantive laws of the State of New York.

Section 4. Amendments

This Assignment Agreement may not be altered, amended or modified except by a writing signed by the party against whom such alteration, amendment or modification is sought to be enforced.

Section 5. Definitions


All the terms not otherwise defined herein shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the Agreement.
