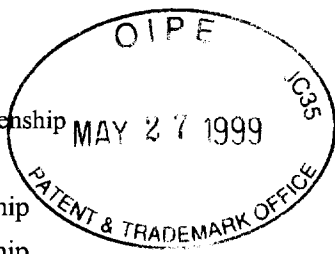

# TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT


This assignment, effective October 7, 1997, witnesseth that:
