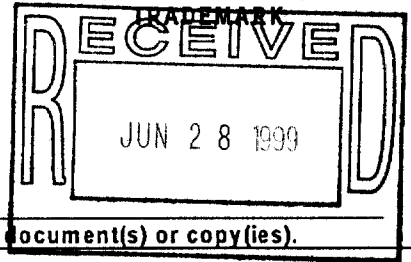

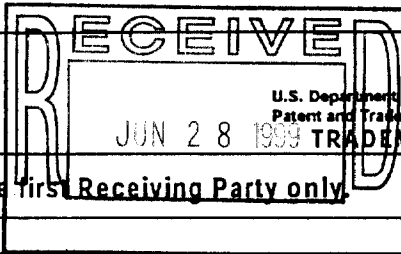


WHEREAS, Assignee is desirous of acquiring the Marks and registration therefor.

ORDER


At Fort Wayne, Indiana, on March 11, 1998.
