Potter Company (hereinafter "Potter") to Arrow Precision Products, Inc., a Pennsylvania corporation (hereinafter "Precision"), as provided in an Asset Purchase Agreement dated July 23, 1990 by and among Precision, Potter, APE, and Louis F.M. Hertzog (hereinafter the "Asset Purchase Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, Assignor agreed pursuant to paragraph 9 of a trademark license agreement (hereinafter the "Potter Trademark Agreement") dated July 23, 1990 by and between Assignor and Potter to assign said Trademarks to Potter, only as said Trademarks pertain to textile flat parts, upon satisfaction of all of the obligations of both Potter and APE to Precision as provided in the Asset Purchase Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Assignor did assign said Trademarks to APE, only as said Trademarks pertained to textile products other than textile flat parts, by Assignment dated September 25, 1995; and Assignor did also assign said Trademarks to Potter, only as said Trademarks pertained to textile flat parts, by Assignment dated September 25, 1995 (the aforesaid assignments hereinafter collectively the "Prior Assignments"); and

WHEREAS, Detroit Tool Metal Products Co., a Missouri corporation, having a place of business at 441 West Elm Street, Lebanon, Missouri 65536 (hereinafter the "Assignee"), did, prior to September 25, 1995, purchase substantially all of the assets of both Potter and APE, and, accordingly, was, as of September 25, 1995, the successor in interest to both Potter's rights under the Potter Trademark Agreement and APE's rights under the APE Trademark Agreement.
