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RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST

WHEREAS, Safety 1st, Inc., a Massachusetts Corporation, and Safety 1st Home Products Canada Inc., a Canadian federal corporation (collectively, the "Borrowers") were obligated to certain banks and financial institutions who were parties to a certain Credit Agreement, dated July 30, 1997 (as amended, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the "Credit Agreement"), among Borrowers, Lenders (as identified in the Credit Agreement), Bankers Trust Company, as issuer of letters of credit (in such capacity, the "Issuing Bank") and BT Commercial Corporation (in such capacity as agent for the Lenders and the Issuing Bank, the "Agent");

WHEREAS, the Borrowers and the Agent entered into a certain Borrower Intellectual Property Security Agreement, dated July 30, 1997 (the "Security Agreement"), which was recorded in favor of the Agent in the United States Patent and Trademark Office on August 25, 1997 on Reel No. 1622, Frame No. 0535;

WHEREAS, pursuant the Security Agreement, to secure the full and prompt payment and performance when due (whether at stated maturity, by acceleration or otherwise) of all of the Obligation (as defined in the Credit Agreement), Borrowers granted and conveyed to the Agent, for the ratable benefit of the Lenders and the Issuing Bank, a valid security interest in all of its rights, title and interest, in the United States and throughout the world, in, to and under all of Borrowers' Trademarks (as defined in the Security Agreement), including the trademark registrations and applications for registration listed in Schedule A hereto; and

WHEREAS, although the Borrowers' Obligations under the existing letters of credit pursuant to the Credit Agreement will not be satisfied as of the date of this Release of Security Interest, the Agent wishes to formally release and reconvey to Borrowers the security interest in all right, title and interest of the Borrowers in and to the Trademarks.

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Agent does hereby release and forever discharge and reconvey to the Borrowers all of the Agent's security interest in the Borrowers' right, title and interest in and to the Trademarks; and Agent does further acknowledge and affirm that all of the rights and remedies of the Agent with respect to the security interest concerning the Trademarks have been and are hereby extinguished.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, Agent has caused this Release of Security Interest to be executed by its duly authorized officer on the 21 th day of October, 1999.
