

ASSIGNMENT OF SERVICE MARK

For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, effective September 1, 1997, Accounting Principals, Inc. ("Accounting Principals"), a Pennsylvania corporation having a principal place of business at 1000 First Avenue, Suite 100, King of Prussia, Pennsylvania 19406, does hereby sell, assign, and transfer to AccuStaff Licensing Corporation, a Florida corporation having a principal place of business at One Independent Drive, Jacksonville, Florida 32202, its successors, assigns, and legal representatives, the entire right, title and interest for the United States and all foreign countries, in and to any and all trademarks, tradenames, service marks and service names (collectively referred to hereinafter as "Intangibles") currently owned by Accounting Principals, including all rights of action, including all rights in Intangibles arising by common law, arising by the filing of an application for registration of an Intangible (excluding applications based on intent to use a mark) in this or another country, or arising by operation of any statute or treaty of the United States (or any state thereof) or any other country, along with the goodwill and business reputation associated with said Intangibles.

Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, Accounting Principals specifically hereby sells, assigns, and transfers to AccuStaff Licensing Corporation the entire right, title, and interest in and to the Intangible registrations and applications (excluding applications based on intent to use a mark) set forth in the attached table entitled "ACTIVE ACCOUNTING PRINCIPALS INTANGIBLE APPLICATIONS AND REGISTRATIONS" along with the goodwill and business reputation associated therewith; agrees to assign to AccuStaff Licensing Corporation all right, title, and interest in and to any and all Intangible registrations issuing on applications based on intent to use a mark when the registrations are granted, along with the goodwill and business reputation associated therewith; and agrees to assign to AccuStaff Licensing Corporation all right, title, interest in and to any and all Intangibles created or acquired by Accounting Principals during these next ten years (unless this agreement is sooner terminated by AccuStaff Licensing Corporation, or extended by mutual agreement) on the same terms as set forth above for the Trademarks currently owned by Accounting Principals.
