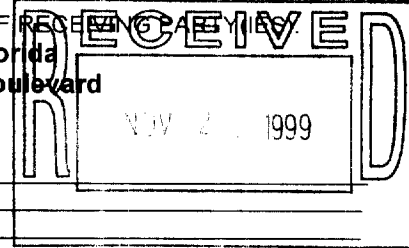





Any dispute which arises by virtue of the sale and assignment of 75/502,112 filed June 12, 1998 will be governed by the laws of the State of FLORIDA.


