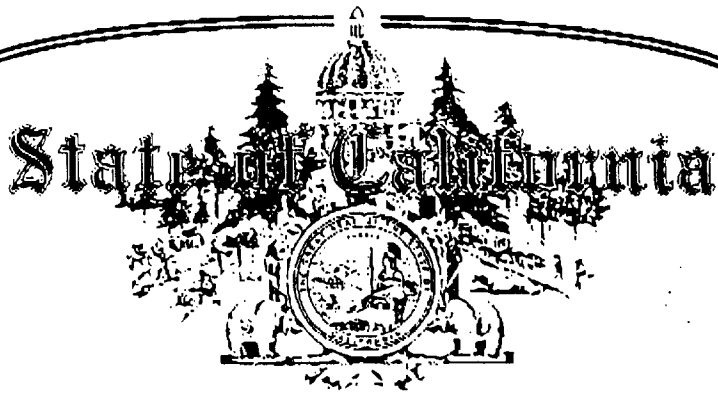

3. The Board of Directors of Pokka Inc. duly adopted the following resolutions:

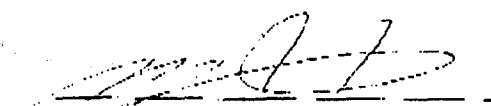
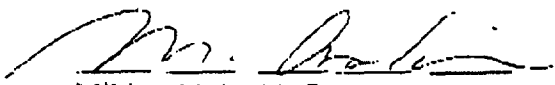
