ORDER

On this date, the Court considered the Trustee's Motion to Approve Sale of Property and Assignment of Trademarks and Names under 11 U.S.C. § 363. The Court finds that the proposed sale is made in good faith and is in the best interest of the Estate and its creditors. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED THAT:

1. The Trustee's motion is **GRANTED**.
2. Specialty Housing and Asset Management of Texas shall immediately pay to the Trustee the sum of \$2,500 (the "Purchase Price").
3. Upon the Trustee's receipt of the Purchase Price, all of the Estate's right, title and interest in the names "Premier Environmental Products, Inc." and "Thuslick, Inc" is transferred and assigned to Specialty Housing and Asset Management of Texas free and clear of all liens and claims.
4. Upon the Trustee's receipt of the Purchase Price, all of the Estate's right, title and interest in the trademarks "Thuslick" and "Thuslick-HF" are transferred and assigned to Specialty Housing and Asset Management of Texas free and clear of all liens and claims.
5. Upon the Trustee's receipt of the Purchase Price, all of the Estate's right, title and interest in and to any net operating loss of Premier Environmental Products, Inc. is assigned to Specialty Housing and Asset Management of Texas.
6. Upon the Trustee's receipt of the Purchase Price, the Trustee shall transfer to Specialty Housing and Asset Management of Texas all sales, marketing, corporate and financial records of Premier Environmental Products, Inc. The Trustee shall have no obligation to take any action to obtain any records that are not in his possession. All records in the Trustee's possession must be picked up within 10 business days of the entry of this Order at the Trustee's facility in Navasota, Texas or such other place as is designated by the Trustee. The Trustee may retain any records necessary to complete his administration of this bankruptcy case, including any records necessary to complete any tax returns that the Trustee is required to complete and file.
7. All transfers and assignments authorized hereunder are made "AS IS", with no representation or warranty of any kind.
