RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST

THIS RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST (this "Release") dated as of March 23, 2000 by Bank Austria Creditanstalt Corporate Finance, Inc., a Delaware corporation (assignee of Creditanstalt-Bankverein) (the "Secured Party").

RECITALS

A. Wayn-Tex Inc., a Virginia corporation, (the "Company"), granted a security interest in the patents and patent applications listed on Schedule A (collectively, the "Patents") to Secured Party (then Creditanstalt-Bankverein) pursuant to a Conditional Assignment of and Grant of Security Interest in Intellectual Property Rights (Patents) (the "Patent Assignment").

B. An executed copy of the Patent Assignment was recorded in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office on November 2, 1992, on Reel 6335, at Frame 0463.

C. The Company granted a security interest in trademark registrations and trademark applications listed on Schedule B (collectively, the "Trademarks") and the goodwill associated therewith to Secured Party (then Creditanstalt-Bankverein) pursuant to a Conditional Assignment of and Grant of Security Interest in Intellectual Property Rights (Trademarks) (the "Trademark Assignment");

D. An executed copy of the Trademark Assignment was recorded in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office on November 2, 1992, on Reel 0906, at Frame 0268.

E. The Company desires that the Secured Party release the security interests in the Patents and Trademarks (collectively, the "Collateral"), and the goodwill of the business symbolized thereby.

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valid consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Secured Party hereby agrees as follows:

1. The Secured Party has not assigned, or otherwise transferred, its aforesaid security interest, or any other interest in any of the Collateral.
2. The Secured Party hereby releases any and all security interests granted to the Secured Party by the Company in the Collateral, and assigns to the Company all right, title and interest it may have in the Collateral, and the goodwill of the business symbolized thereby.
3. The Company hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States of America to note and record the existence of the release hereby created.

4. The release of the security interest pursuant to the Agreement is with respect to the each of the patents, patent applications, trademark registrations and trademark applications set forth on the attached Schedules, and the goodwill associated therewith.
