This is in reference to your letter of February 8, 2000 on the above referenced matter. Specifically, Union Federal intends to change its corporate title to Union Federal Bank of Indianapolis, effective February 15, 2000.

According to the information provided to this Office, the Board of Directors of Union Federal adopted a resolution on January 14, 2000. The sole shareholder of the institution, Waterfield Mortgage Company, Inc., approved the proposed amendment to Section 1 of the Charter on January 31, 2000.

We find the Charter amendment is in conformity with the current regulations at 12 C.F.R. §552.2. We are returning a copy of your letter of February 8, 2000, duly stamped, demonstrating its filing with this Office.

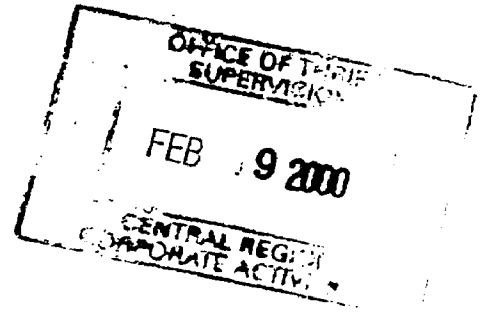

Dear David:

As of January 14, 2000, the Board of Directors of Union Federal Savings Bank of Indianapolis (the "Bank"), based in Indianapolis, Indiana, adopted resolutions relating to an amendment of Section 1 of the Federal Stock Charter of that federal thrift to change its name to Union Federal Bank of Indianapolis. Enclosed are the resolutions adopted by the Board of Directors relating to this amendment.

Effective as of January 31, 2000, the sole shareholder of the Bank approved the amendment. A copy of the resolutions adopted by such shareholder by written consent is also enclosed.

The name change is to become effective February 15, 2000.

We believe the proposed amendment is permissible under all applicable laws, rules or regulations and are filing these documents with your office pursuant to 12 C.F.R. §552.4(a) and (b).
