WHEREAS Robinton Products, Inc. has obtained a federal mark registration No. 1,388,182 dated April 1, 1986 (the "Registration") for the mark INTELIMETER (the "Mark") in connection with electrical power measuring apparatus;

WHEREAS Robinton Products, Inc. has assigned the entire interest in the Mark and the Registration, together with the good will of the business symbolized by the Mark, to Security Pacific National Bank by an assignment recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office at Reel 0790, Frame 0682 on June 3, 1991;

WHEREAS Security Pacific National Bank has assigned the entire interest in the Mark and the Registration, together with the good will of the business symbolized by the Mark, to Neta Corporation of America by an assignment recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office at Reel 0790, Frame 0686 on June 3, 1991;

WHEREAS, Neta Corporation of America has assigned all of its rights in the Mark and the Registration, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by the Mark, to Neta Corporation of Canada on October 21, 1991, and Neta Corporation of America has memorialized the said assignment by a nunc pro tunc assignment dated July 29, 1995;

WHEREAS, Neta Corporation of Canada has assigned all of its rights in the Mark and the Registration, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by the Mark, to GD

California, Inc. on October 21, 1991, and GD California, Inc. has subsequently changed its corporate name to Intellimeter Corporation by filing a certificate of amendment to Articles of Incorporation of GD California, Inc. with the Secretary of State of the State of California on March 29, 1993, and Neta Corporation of Canada has memorialized the said assignment by a nunc pro tunc assignment to Intellimeter Corporation dated July 29, 1994;

WHEREAS Intellimeter Corporation of 410 Cliffside Drive, Danville, California 94526 has adopted, has used and is using the Mark in connection with the goods specified in the Registration, in the United States and in Canada and elsewhere, and has acquired rights in the Mark by virtue of such use;

WHEREAS, Intellimeter Corporation has granted a security interest in the Mark and the Registration to Cupertino National Bank of 20230 Stevens Creek Boulevard, Cupertino, California 95014 pursuant to a certain loan agreement, and Intellimeter Corporation has defaulted on the said loan agreement, and Cupertino National Bank has acquired the entire right, title and interest of Intellimeter Corporation in and to Mark, in the United States, Canada, and all other nations in which Intellimeter, Inc. has used the Mark, including all claims for damages for past infringement, together with the good will of the business symbolized by the Mark, and the Registration, as a result of the said default, and by an assignment dated March 31, 1995, a copy of which is attached hereto; and

WHEREAS Ohio Semitronics, Inc., a corporation of the State of Ohio having offices located at 4242 Reynolds Drive, Hilliard, Ohio 43026, is desirous of acquiring the Mark and the registration thereof from Cupertino National Bank;

NOW, THEREFORE, Cupertino National Bank, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration, paid to it from Ohio Semitronics, Inc., the receipt and sufficiency of which it acknowledges, by this Assignment;

Does hereby sell, assign, and transfer to Ohio Semitronics, Inc. its entire right, title and interest in and to the Mark, in the United States, Canada and all other nations in which Intellimeter, Inc. has used the Mark, including all claims for damages for past infringement, together with the good will of the business symbolized by the Mark, and the Registration, which Cupertino National Bank has acquired from Intellimeter Corporation as a result of the said default, and by the said assignment dated March 31, 1995.

Cupertino National Bank makes the foregoing assignment without recourse to it, and without representation or warranty of any kind, express or implied, provided, however, that Cupertino National Bank does hereby agree that the foregoing assignment transfers whatever right, title and interest Cupertino National Bank may presently have in the aforesaid Mark, good will and Registration.

Cupertino National Bank covenants that it will not execute, grant, or transfer any rights or interests inconsistent herewith and that it will execute and deliver to Ohio Semitronics, Inc., its successors and assigns, any further documents or instruments that may be reasonably necessary to vest in Cupertino National Bank, its successors and assigns, the title herein conveyed and
