Petitioner. :

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A proceeding having been commenced by Petitioner, Den norske Bank (U.S.) Banking Corporation (the "Company") on February 20, 1992 by service of a notice of petition and verified petition together with exhibits for a closing order pursuant to Section 605 of New York Banking Law, and a request for judicial intervention having been filed on February 25, 1992, and the proceeding having been assigned to Individual Assignment Part 26, the Honorable Kristan Booth Glen, a Justice of this Court, and the Superintendent of Banks, New York State Department of Banking (the "Superintendent") having been served, and proof of said service having been duly filed with the Court and the application for a closing order having duly come on to be heard before the Court on the 10th day of March, 1992 and

White & Case, attorneys for the Company, having appeared in support of the application for a closing order and the Superintendent having interposed no objection to the petition or application for closing order;

And the Court having issued a closing order dated March 10, 1992 (the "Closing Order") setting forth various procedures for the Company to comply with in order to return to the Court to apply for a dissolution order;

And as required by the Closing Order and Section 605(5) of New York Banking Law, the Company having served a verified statement concerning the status of its creditors and depositors, sworn to by Stephen V. Killorin, First Vice President and Comptroller of the Company, on May 14, 1992, and said statement certifying that the Company no longer has any depositors or creditors and that it has no unclaimed funds;

And the Company having given notice of its compliance with the provisions of the Closing Order and having made a further application for a dissolution order pursuant to Section 605 of New York Banking Law, and having served the Superintendent and the Comptroller of the State of New York, as required by Section 605(6) of New York Banking Law, and proof of said service having been duly filed with the Court, and the application for a dissolution order having been noticed for return on May 26, 1992 and

adjourned to June 2, 1992 on notice to all parties and said application having duly come on to be heard before the Court on the 2nd day of June, 1992 and White & Case, attorneys for the Company, having appeared in support of the application for a dissolution order and the Superintendent having interposed no objection to the application for a dissolution order and no other objections having been interposed

NOW, upon reading and filing the notice of compliance with the Closing Order and application for a dissolution order, and the verified statement in support of the same, sworn to by Stephen V. Killorin, First Vice President and Comptroller of the Company, on May 14, 1992, together with its annexed exhibits, including the verified statement concerning the status of its creditors and depositors, with proof of service, it is hereby

ORDERED that the application of the Company for a dissolution order is granted without opposition; and it is further


ORDERED that upon service of a copy of this order with notice of entry, pursuant to Section 605(6) of New York Banking Law, the Company is hereby declared dissolved; and it is further

ORDERED that pursuant to Section 605(7) of New York Banking Law, the Company is directed to file a

of this order with the Superintendent, the Company's
corporate existence shall be terminated.
