AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FIRST: The name of the corporation shall be WorldCom Advanced Networks

Incorporated.

SECOND: The place in Ohio where the principal office is to be located is the City of

Hilliard, Franklin County.

THIRD: The purpose for which it is formed is to engage in any lawful act or activity for

which corporations may be formed under Section 1701.01 to 1701.98, inclusive, of the Ohio

Revised Code.

FOURTH: The maximum number of shares which the corporation is authorized to have

outstanding is 750, all of which shall be common shares without par value.

FIFTH: The board of directors may fix and determine, and vary, the amount of working

capital of the corporation, determine whether any (and if any, what part) of the surplus, however

created or arising, shall be used or disposed of or declared in dividends or paid to shareholders,

and, without action by the shareholders, use and apply such surplus, or any part thereof, or such

part of the stated capital of the corporation as is permitted under the laws of the State of Ohio, at

any time or from time to time, in the purchase or acquisition of shares of any class, voting-trust

certificates for shares, bonds, debentures, notes, scripts, warrants, obligations, evidence of

SIXTH: Every statute of the State of Ohio hereafter enacted, whereby rights or

privileges of shareholders of a corporation organized under the General Corporation Law of said


state are increased, diminished, or in any way affected, or whereby effect is given to any action
