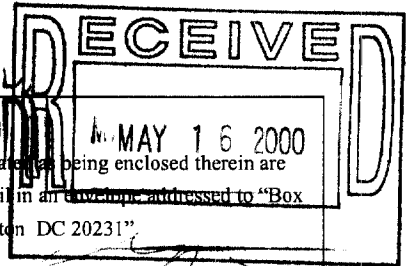

Assignment of Trademark


