ASSIGNMENT OF TRADEMARK RIGHTS

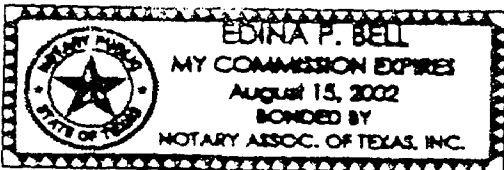

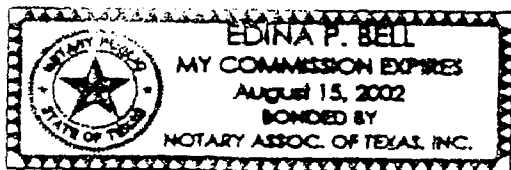
