

TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

This TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT is made and entered into this 30th day of June, 2000 by and between Sakura, Inc., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York, having a principal place of business at 41 Madison Avenue, New York, New York 10010 (the "Assignor"), and Oneida, Ltd., a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York, having a principal place of business at 163-181 Kenwood Avenue, Oneida, New York 13421 (the "Assignee").

WHEREAS, Assignor and Assignee are parties to that certain Asset Purchase Agreement by and among Oneida Community China, Inc. ("Oneida Community China"), Assignee, Assignor, Glen Simon, and Nick Nishiwaki, dated May 23, 2000 (the "Asset Purchase Agreement"), pursuant to which Oneida Community China agreed to purchase certain assets of Assignor related to the Assignor's Business (as defined in the Asset Purchase Agreement), including the Subject Trademarks (as defined below);

NOW, THEREFORE, for the consideration set forth in the Asset Purchase Agreement and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Assignor hereby:

1. sells, assigns and transfers to Assignee all right, title and interest in and to the Subject Trademarks, including all rights therein provided by international conventions and treaties.
