ORDER

On this date, the Court considered the Trustee's Motion to Approve Sale of Property under 11 U.S.C. § 363(f). The Court finds that the proposed sale is made in good faith and is in the best interest of the Estate and its creditors. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED THAT:

1. The Trustee's motion is **GRANTED**.
2. Nalco Chemical Company shall immediately pay to the Trustee the sum of \$2,500 (the "Purchase Price").
3. Upon the Trustee's receipt of the Purchase Price, all of the Estate's right, title and interest in and to the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office registration no. 2,195,819 for the mark THUSLICK HF, in International Class 004, for siliconized micronized graphite lubricants used in oil and water well drilling, the mark upon which it is based and the good will associated therewith is transferred and assigned to Nalco Chemical Company free and clear of all liens and claims.
4. The transfer and assignment hereunder are subject to any rights previously transferred under the Court's December 14, 1999 Order.
5. All transfers and assignments authorized hereunder are made "AS IS", with no representation or warranty of any kind.
6. The Trustee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate the sale and assignment.
