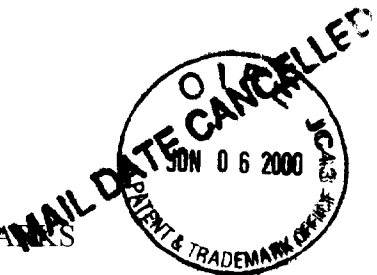



ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, The Forgotten Woman, Inc. (hereinafter Debtor), a corporation duly organized under and existing by virtue of the laws of the State of Delaware, formerly located and doing business at 888 Lexington Avenue, New York, New York 11101, has acquired through mesne conveyances and was using the following Marks in connection with "Women's wearing apparel, namely, pants, skirts, vests, jackets, dresses, blouses, tennis dresses, tennis shorts and panties, tennis blouses, tennis jackets, tennis sweaters, bathing suits, fur coats and fur jackets and belts" (hereinafter Goods) and "Retail store services specializing in women's wearing apparel and accessories" (hereinafter Services) for which it owns the following identified U.S. trademark registrations:

WHEREAS, on or about September 23, 1998, an involuntary petition for reorganization under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code was filed against the Debtor in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York - Case No. 98 B 46787;

WHEREAS, by Order of the Court dated November 13, 1998, the Debtor's Chapter 11 case was converted to a case under Chapter 7 of the United States Bankruptcy Code;

WHEREAS, by Appointment of the Office of the United States Trustee (Carolyn S. Schwartz) on November 13, 1998, Hal Hirsch was appointed as Interim Trustee for the estate of the Debtor;

WHEREAS, by Order of the Court dated February 1, 1999, the Court authorized the Trustee (Hal Hirsch) to sell the Marks to Sanford Zimmerman, 423 State Street, Albany, New York 12203, for Ten Thousand Dollars (\$ 10,000) if Sanford Zimmerman deposited the money in escrow with the Trustee (Hal Hirsch) by December 21, 1998;

WHEREAS, the Trustee (Hal Hirsch) represents and warrants that Sanford Zimmerman timely paid the Ten Thousand Dollars (\$ 10,000) to the estate of the Debtor;

WHEREAS, it is desired to confirm such assignment and transfer of said Marks and the goodwill of the business symbolized thereby and the U.S. Trademark Registrations and to make the same a matter of record in the United States Patent and Trademark Office;

Now, for good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, effective as of December 21, 1998, the Trustee (Hal Hirsch) on behalf of the Debtor does hereby sell, assign and transfer unto the said Sanford Zimmerman the entire right, title and interest in and to the Marks, together with the good will of the business symbolized by the Marks, and the said U.S. trademark registrations.

Said trademarks and trademark registrations to be held and enjoyed by the said Sanford Zimmerman for its own use and behoof, and for its successors and assigns, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by the said Debtor had this assignment and sale not been made.


