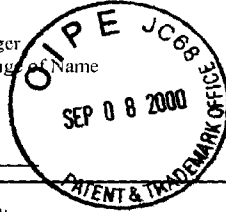

## CONFIRMATORY TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

This Assignment is by and between Kabushiki Kaisha Kobe Seiko Sho t/a Kobe Steel, Ltd. a Japanese corporation, located and doing business at 3-18, 1-Chome, Wakinohama-cho, Chuo-ku, Kobe, Japan ("Assignor") and Mitsubishi Engineering-Plastics Corporation, a Japanese corporation, located and doing business at 1-1, Kyobashi 1-Chome, Chuo-ku, Tokyo, Japan ("Assignee").

WHEREAS, the parties have previously executed an Assignment dated June 1, 2000 which includes the transfer of any and all trademark rights of Assignor in and to the trademarks KOBATRON and KOBALLOY; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to confirm such transfer in a short form document suitable for recordation in the United States Patent and Trademark Office and elsewhere as necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exchange for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged one party to the other, it is agreed:

1. Assignor was, as of the date of executing the aforementioned Agreement, the owner of the trademarks KOBATRON and KOBALLOY as reflected by United States pending trademark application Serial Nos. 75/384,207 and 75/384,212 filed on November 4, 1997, as well as common law rights therein and any and all pertinent goodwill attached thereto.
