BOOKS THAT WORK U.S. TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

3. Assignor hereby promises and agrees to communicate to the said Assignee and its successors, assigns and legal representatives any facts known to Assignor respecting said Trademarks, and to testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, make all rightful oaths

and generally do everything possible to aid the said Assignee and its successors, assigns and legal representatives to obtain and enforce proper protection for said Trademarks.
