**ASSIGNMENT**

WHEREAS, American Medical Laboratories, Inc. of Chantilly, Virginia ("AML") submitted a Complaint to the National Arbitration Forum ("The Forum") on July 10, 2000 against David A. Colondres, of Coppell, Texas ("Respondent") requesting that a Three Member Panel be convened to have a dispute between AML and Respondent regarding rights to the names LABPORTAL.COM and LAB-PORTAL.COM; decided in accordance with ICANN's Uniform Dispute Resolution Policy (UDRP);


WHEREAS, The Forum appointed a three member panel to decide the dispute;

WHEREAS, the appointed panel unanimously found (the "Decision") for AML and against Respondent and ordered (the "Order") the subject domain names, to wit: LABPORTAL.COM and LAB-PORTAL.COM transferred from Respondent to AML; and

WHEREAS, AML is owner of the trademark LABPORTAL, Serial No. 75/881,819 and the servicemark LABPORTAL.COM, Serial No. 75/881,820 and desires to transfer all rights, title and interest in said trademark and servicemark, the good will of the business associated therewith and all its rights, title and interest to the domain names LABPORTAL.COM and LAB-PORTAL.COM and any and all rights and interest granted under and flowing from the Decision and the Order to LabPortal, Inc. of Chantilly, Virginia.

NOW, THEREFORE, for the sum of \$1.00 and other good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, AML does hereby transfer to LabPortal, Inc. all its rights, title and interest unto said marks LABPORTAL and LABPORTAL.COM, including the goodwill of the business associated with said marks, and any and all rights granted and flowing to AML under the Decision of the Forum with respect to the domain names LABPORTAL.COM and LAB-PORTAL.COM.
