TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, FundsXpress, Inc., a Delaware corporation, (the "Purchaser"), and CUville.com, Inc. d/b/a Good2CU.com, a Delaware corporation ("Seller") entered into an Asset Acquisition Agreement effective as of July 26, 2000 regarding the purchase by Purchaser from Seller of the business, operations, certain tangible and intangible assets and goodwill associated with the business of Seller relating to the operation of a Supersite Portal for banks and credit unions on the Internet;

WHEREAS, Seller has adopted, owns rights in, is using or has used various trademarks, service marks and trade names (collectively, the "Marks") in association with the sale of its services, some of which Seller either has applied to register on the Principal Register of the United States Patent and Trademark Office as listed in Schedule A for the services identified therein;

WHEREAS, the purchase of the business from Seller includes the transfer of any and all rights owned by Seller in the Marks including, but not limited to, 1) rights in any and all marks or names owned by Seller that are listed on Schedule 2.1g attached to the Asset Acquisition Agreement or as such report may be updated prior to closing and 2) rights in the subsisting or pending United States application listed in Schedule A (the "Listed Mark") together with any associated goodwill;

WHEREAS, Purchaser desires to acquire the Mark, including the applications listed in Schedule A;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Seller does hereby sell, assign, transfer, set over and convey to Purchaser any and all of Seller's rights, title and interest in and to the Mark and all goodwill associated with the business symbolized by the Mark, as well as any pending application or issued registration thereof as listed in Schedule A.



Seller will no longer claim rights in the Mark and will no longer use the Mark either inside or outside the United States.

Seller agrees to promptly prepare, execute, and deliver to Purchaser or its legal representatives any and all papers, instruments or affidavits which may be necessary or useful to cause and permit Purchaser to effect the terms of this Assignment.



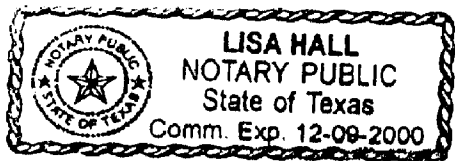

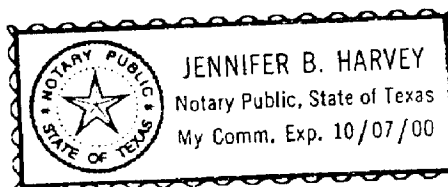
