TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, American Medical Services, LLC, a Virginia limited liability company with its principal place of business at P.O. Box 2272, Norfolk, Virginia 23501 ("Assignor"), has adopted, owns and is using the following mark (the "Mark"):



1. Assignor hereby sells, assigns and transfers to Assignee all of the Assignor's right, title and interest in and to the Mark, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by the Mark, and the federal registration of the Mark.
2. Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to record Assignee as the assignee and owner of the Marks and applications.
3. Assignor hereby agrees to provide to Assignee, its successors, assigns or legal representatives, reasonable cooperation and assistance at Assignee's request (including the execution and delivery of any and all affidavits, declarations and other documentation as may be reasonably required): (1) in the preparation and prosecution of any application for registration or any application for renewal of a registration covering the Mark; (2) in the prosecution or defense of any oppositions, infringement suits or proceedings that may arise in connection with the Mark, including, but not limited to, testifying as to any facts relating to the Mark; (3) in obtaining any additional trademark protection that Assignor reasonably may deem appropriate that may be secured under the laws now or hereafter in effect in the United States or throughout the world; and (4) in the implementation or perfection of this Assignment.
