right to grant the assignment hereunder without the consent of any third party, the Intellectual Properties are free and clear of all liens, claims, encumbrances, licenses or any other rights of any third party; and, upon the execution and delivery of this instrument, Assignee will own all right, title and interest in and to the Intellectual Properties.





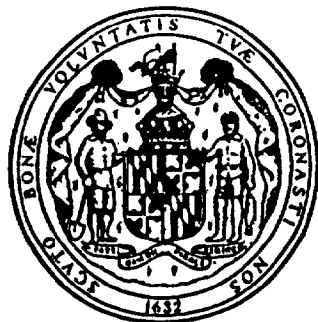
