

RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST IN
INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

THIS RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST IN INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ("Release") is made as of December 4, 2000, by Comerica Bank-California, a California corporation with a principal business address of 600 "B" Street, San Diego, California 92101 ("Secured Party"), in favor of Maxwell Electronics Components Group, Inc., a California corporation with a principal business address of 9244 Balboa Avenue, San Diego, California 92123 ("Company").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Space Electronics, Inc., a Delaware corporation, has previously granted a security interest to Metrobank in the trademarks and patents listed on Schedule A attached hereto (collectively, the "Released Collateral"); and

WHEREAS, said security interest was recorded with the Assignment Branch of the United States Patent and Trademark Office on September 27, 1996, and recorded at Reel/Frame: 1522/0353; and

WHEREAS, Company is the successor to Space Electronics, Inc. through a merger of Space Electronics, Inc., with and into Company. Documentation of such merger was filed for recordation with the United States Patent and Trademark Office on October 30, 2000.

WHEREAS, Secured Party is the successor to Metrobank.

WHEREAS, Company has satisfied its obligations that were secured by the Released Collateral ;

WHEREAS, Secured Party has agreed to release all its rights in the Released Collateral and to reconvey any and all rights it may have in the Released Collateral to Company:

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and value consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Secured Party releases, without recourse or warranty, and reconveys to Company, all its right, title, claim and interest in and to the Released Collateral, all proceeds thereof, all rights corresponding thereto including but not limited to all renewals, and extensions thereof, and the recordings and applications therefore.
2. Secured Party hereby represents and warrants that it has not transferred any rights in the Released Collateral to any other party.
3. This Release may be executed in two counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original and all such counterparts shall constitute but one and the same instrument.
