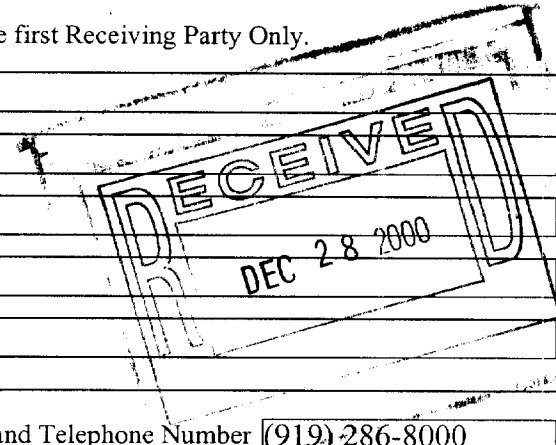

ASSIGNMENT OF TRADEMARKS AND ACCOMPANYING GOODWILL

WHEREAS, JERI-JO KNITWEAR, INC., a New York corporation, whose address is 463 Seventh Avenue, New York, New York, 10018, (hereinafter the "Assignor"), has adopted, used, is using and is the owner of the trademarks and the applications and registrations therefor in the United States Patent and Trademark Office and in any similar office or agency of any other country or any political subdivision thereof, more fully set forth on the attached Exhibit "A," and all rights appurtenant thereto, including, but not limited to, all common law rights, causes of action and the right to recover for past infringement, dilution or other misappropriation thereof (hereinafter collectively the "Trademarks");

Assignor agrees to perform all reasonable and proper additional acts and to execute any additional documents at the request and expense of Assignee which Assignee may require in order to vest all of Assignor's rights, title and interest in and to the Trademarks in Assignee, its successors or assigns.


