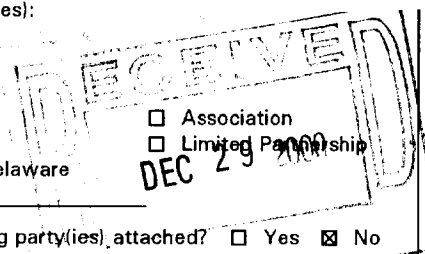

INTEREST IN CERTAIN U.S. TRADEMARKS**






