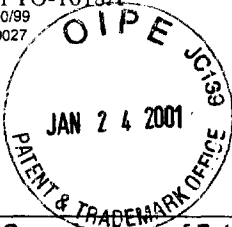

TRADEMARK AND COPYRIGHT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

THIS TRADEMARK AND COPYRIGHT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made this 6th day of March, 2000, between Paytech Corporation, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Nebraska, with its corporate domicile at 414 South 14th Street, Omaha, Nebraska 68102 ("the Assignor"), and International Payments Corporation, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Nebraska, with its corporate domicile at 414 South 14th Street, Omaha, Nebraska 68102 ("the Assignee").

WHEREAS, the Assignor has adopted and used in the United States the EasyPayPlus trademark (the "Trademark") and is the owner of the application for federal trademark registration therefor, which such application bears the Serial Number 75827767 (the "Application").

WHEREAS, the Assignee wishes to acquire all of the Assignor's rights in and to the Trademark and the Application, together with any goodwill associated therewith.

WHEREAS, the Assignor is the author and owner of all rights, title and interests in and to the entire computer software program code for the computer software program entitled EasyPayPlus, and is the sole owner of all copyrights in same.

WHEREAS, the Assignee desires to acquire the entire copyright interest of the Assignor in such software.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

ASSIGNMENT

- a) The Assignor hereby assigns, transfers and conveys to the Assignee all rights, title and interests in and to the Trademark and the Application, together with any goodwill associated therewith.
- b) The Assignor hereby assigns, transfers and conveys to the Assignee, all rights, title and interests in and to the entire program code for the EasyPayPlus computer software program, and in and to all copyrights therein (including but not limited to the copyright interests represented by the Certificate of Copyright Registration attached hereto), together with the right to secure renewals, reissues, and extensions of such copyrights, which interests and rights shall be held to the full end of the term for which such copyrights or renewals or extensions thereof is or may be granted.
- c) The Assignor hereby agrees to give, execute and/or deliver any document, notice, agreement or other evidence of assignment as may be reasonably necessary to evidence or effectuate any of the foregoing.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

- a) This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof, and supersedes all previous or contemporaneous representations, understandings or other communications, either verbal or written, between the parties concerning such subject matter.
- b) This Agreement is freely assignable and transferable by the Assignee without any further compensation due or owing to the Assignor or any other person or entity.
