

**ASSIGNMENT OF TRADEMARK
AND ACCOMPANYING BUSINESS AND GOODWILL**

THIS ASSIGNMENT made *nunc pro tunc* effective as of the 3rd day of March, 2000, by and between CHANCEPTS, L.L.C., a North Carolina limited liability company, located at 800 East Boulevard, Charlotte, North Carolina 28203, (hereinafter the "Assignor"), and INVENCOM, L.L.C., a North Carolina limited liability company, located at 800 East Boulevard, Charlotte, North Carolina 28203, (hereinafter the "Assignee").

WHEREAS, Assignor is the owner of all rights, title and interest in and to the mark RAMTECH, and the pending application for registration thereof in the United States Patent and Trademark Office, Serial No. 75/789,188, (the "Mark"), and all rights appurtenant thereto, including, but not limited to, all common law rights, causes of action and the right to recover for past infringement, dilution or other misappropriation thereof; and

WHEREAS, Assignee is desirous of acquiring Assignor's rights in the Mark and the pending trademark application therefor in the United States, and all rights appurtenant thereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of Ten and No/100 Dollars (\$10.00) and for other good and valuable consideration, receipt of which Assignor acknowledges by its execution below:

1. Assignor assigns to Assignee *nunc pro tunc* effective as of March 3, 2000 all of its rights, title and interest in and to the mark RAMTECH and the pending application for registration thereof in the United States Patent and Trademark Office, Serial No. 75/789,188, together with the goodwill of the business connected with the use of and symbolized by said Mark and that portion of Assignor's business which pertains to the referenced intent-to-use application filed pursuant to Section 1(b) of the United States Trademark Act (15 U.S.C. § 1051, *et seq.*), and together with any and all interests, claims and rights for damages and profits by reason of any past infringement or unauthorized use of the Mark, false designations of origin, unfair competition, deceptive trade practices and/or dilution related to the Mark, use of confusingly similar marks or names by others and all other related causes of action and the right to sue therefor.

2. Assignor agrees to perform all reasonable and proper additional acts and to execute any additional documents at the request and expense of Assignee which Assignee may require in order to transfer all of Assignor's rights, title and interest in and to the said Mark and trademark application in the United States to Assignee, its successors or assigns.
