

ASSIGNMENT OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

WHEREAS, **LongBoard, Inc.** (f/k/a **Magellan Network Systems, Inc.**, a California corporation ("ASSIGNOR"), pursuant to that certain Asset Transfer Agreement, dated as of April 30, 1998, between ASSIGNOR, Michael S. Colbert and **Access Communications, Inc.**, a Hawaii corporation, acquired all right, title, and interest in and to the trademark "**Ability®**" and Registration No. 2,225,739 therefor, registered with the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office on February 23, 1999, and the good will of the business connected with and symbolized thereby(collectively, the "**Intellectual Property**"); and

WHEREAS, ASSIGNOR currently owns all right, title, and interest in and to the Intellectual Property and the good will of the business connected with and symbolized thereby; and

WHEREAS, ASSIGNOR and Intertech Management Group Inc., a Missouri corporation ("**ASSIGNEE**"), have entered into an agreement pursuant to which ASSIGNEE is acquiring all right, title, and interest in and to the Intellectual Property and the good will of the business connected with and symbolized thereby.

NOW, THEREFORE, for the consideration given pursuant to the agreement between ASSIGNOR and ASSIGNEE and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, ASSIGNOR, intending to be legally bound hereby, agrees as follows:

1. ASSIGNOR, as of the date of this Assignment, hereby assigns, transfers, and sells to ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns and legal representatives the full and exclusive right, title, and interest in and to the Intellectual Property and the good will of the business connected with the use of and symbolized thereby, including without limitation the right to sue for past, present and future infringements thereof, all rights corresponding thereto and all applications, registrations, renewals, and extensions thereof.

2. ASSIGNOR, further agrees to execute any and all Powers of Attorney, applications, assignments, declarations, affidavits and any other papers in connection therewith necessary to perfect in ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns and legal representatives all right, title and interest to the interests conveyed by this Assignment.

3. This Assignment may be executed by telecopy and in one or more counterparts, each of which will for all purposes be deemed to be an original and all of which will constitute the same instrument.
